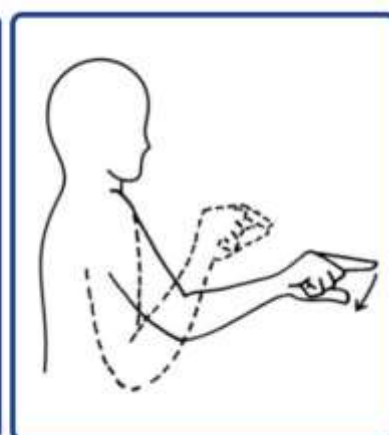
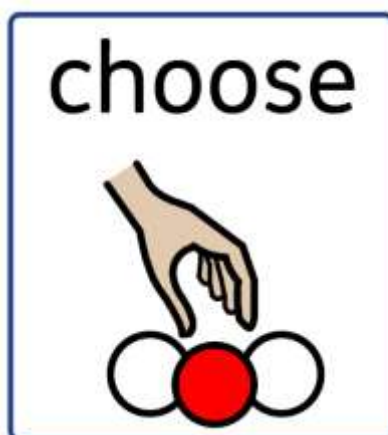
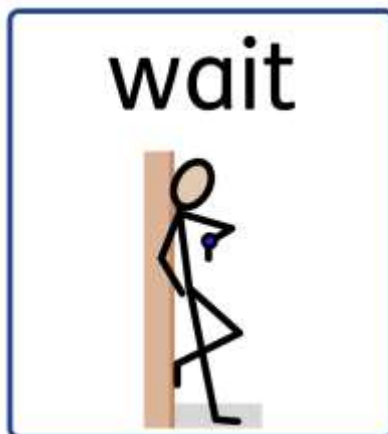


**Class Update:**
